

Note: The channel-to-ambient thermal resistance,  $R_{th(ch-a)}$ , and the power dissipation,  $P_D$ , vary according to the board material, board area, board thickness and pad area. When using this device, be sure to take heat dissipation fully into account.

Note 1: If a reverse bias is applied between gate and source, this device enters  $V_{(BR)DSX}$  mode. Note that the drain-source breakdown voltage is lowered in this mode.

Note 2: Let  $V_{th}$  be the voltage applied between gate and source that causes the drain current ( $I_D$ ) to below (-1 mA for this device). Then, for normal switching operation,  $V_{GS(ON)}$  must be higher than  $V_{th}$ , and  $V_{GS(OFF)}$  must be lower than  $V_{th}$ . This relationship can be expressed as:  $V_{GS(OFF)} < V_{th} < V_{GS(ON)}$ .






Fig. 6.3.1 Test Circuit of Switching Time




Fig. 7.1 Marking





Fig. 8.1 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>DS</sub>



Gate-source voltage V<sub>GS</sub> (V) Fig. 8.3 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - V<sub>GS</sub>




Fig. 8.5 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - I<sub>D</sub>




Fig. 8.2 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>GS</sub>




Fig. 8.4 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - V<sub>GS</sub>




Fig. 8.6 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>

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


Fig. 8.7 V<sub>th</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 8.8 |Y<sub>fs</sub>| - I<sub>D</sub>




Fig. 8.9 IDR - VDS




Fig. 8.10 C - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.11 t - I<sub>D</sub>





Fig. 8.12 Dynamic Input Characteristics








Fig. 8.13 r<sub>th</sub> - t<sub>w</sub>


Fig. 8.14 P<sub>D</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>
