




Fig. 4.1 Definitions of Electrical Characteristics




Fig. 5.1 Marking




Fig. 6.1 Land Pattern Dimensions (Unit: mm)


Reverse voltage  $V_R$  (V) Fig. 7.3 C<sub>t</sub> - V<sub>R</sub>






### 8. Clamp Voltage - Peak Pulse Current (V<sub>C</sub> - I<sub>PP</sub>) (Note)

## 9. ESD Clamp Waveform (Note)








