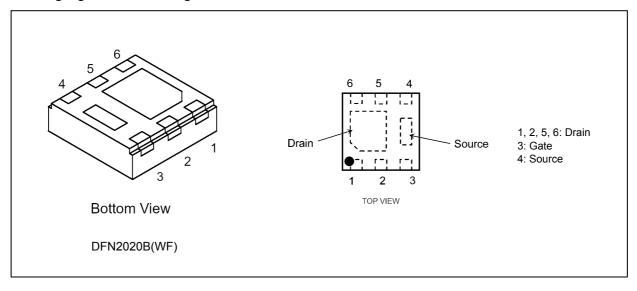

- Note 5: The definitions of the absolute maximum channel and storage temperatures are qualified per AEC-Q101.
- Note: This transistor is sensitive to electrostatic discharge and should be handled with care.
- Note: The MOSFETs in this device are sensitive to electrostatic discharge. When handling this device, the worktables, operators, soldering irons and other objects should be protected against anti-static discharge.
- Note: The channel-to-ambient thermal resistance, R<sub>th(ch-a)</sub>, and the drain power dissipation, P<sub>D</sub>, vary according to the board material, board area, board thickness and pad area. When using this device, be sure to take heat dissipation fully into account.

Note 1: If a reverse bias is applied between gate and source, this device enters  $V_{(BR)DSX}$  mode. Note that the drain-source breakdown voltage is lowered in this mode.

Note 2: Let V<sub>th</sub> be the voltage applied between gate and source that causes the drain current (I<sub>D</sub>) to below (0.1 mA for this device). Then, for normal switching operation, V<sub>GS(ON)</sub> must be higher than V<sub>th</sub>, and V<sub>GS(OFF)</sub> must be lower than V<sub>th</sub>. This relationship can be expressed as: V<sub>GS(OFF)</sub> < V<sub>th</sub> < V<sub>GS(ON)</sub>.

Take this into consideration when using the device.

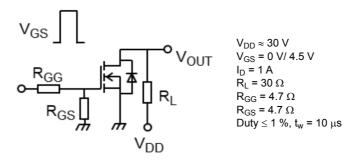


Fig. 6.2.1 Switching Time Test Circuit

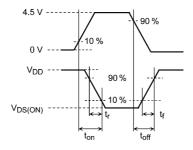


Fig. 6.2.2 Input Waveform/Output Waveform

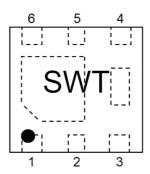

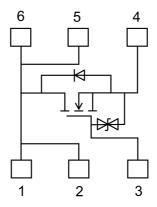

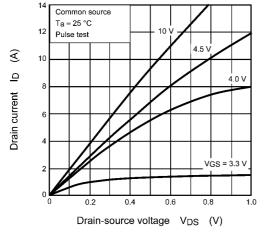


Fig. 9.1 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>DS</sub>

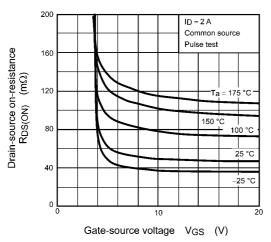


Fig. 9.3 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - V<sub>GS</sub>

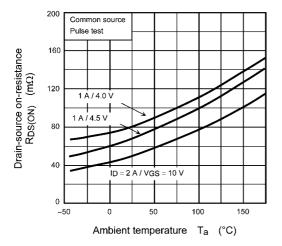


Fig. 9.5 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>

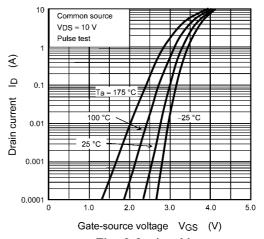


Fig. 9.2 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>GS</sub>

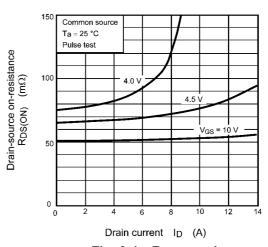
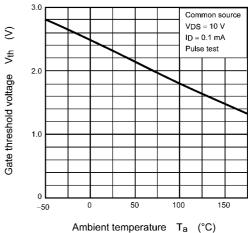
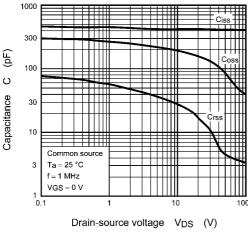


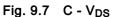
Fig. 9.4 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - I<sub>D</sub>



Ambient temperature Ta (C)







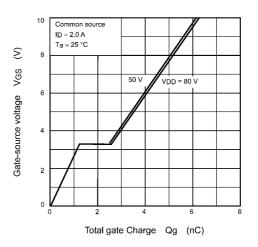


Fig. 9.8 Dynamic Input Characteristics

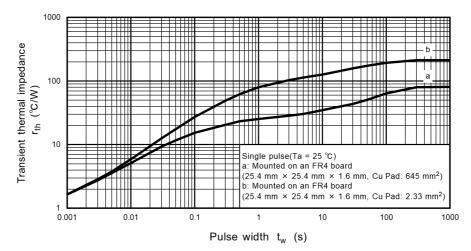


Fig. 9.9 rth - tw

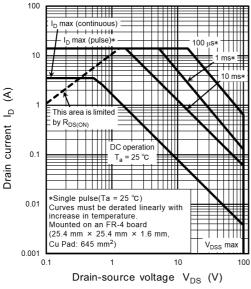


Fig. 9.10 Safe Operating Area

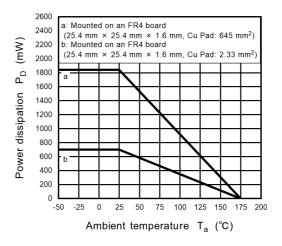


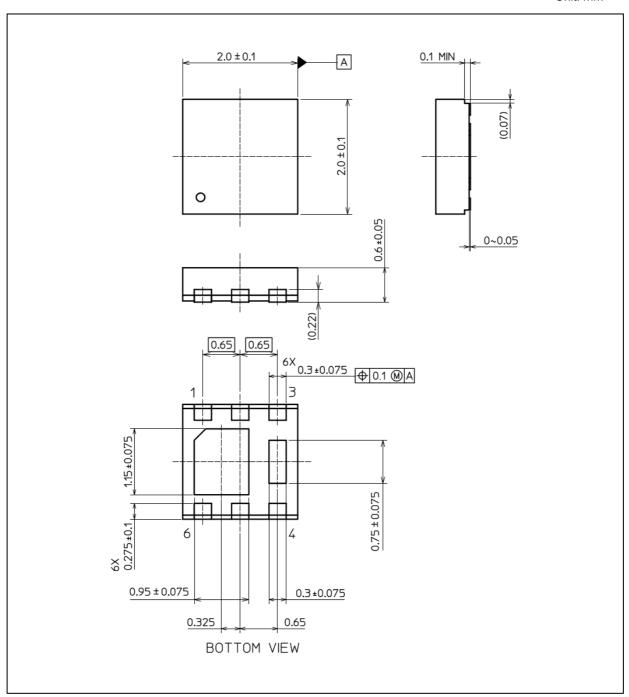
Fig. 9.11 P<sub>D</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>
